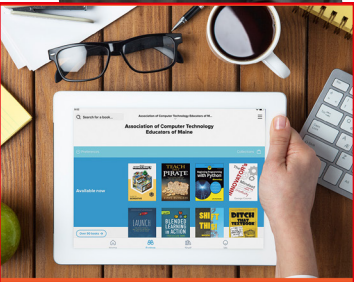
### Ignite Sessions After the Keynote

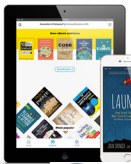

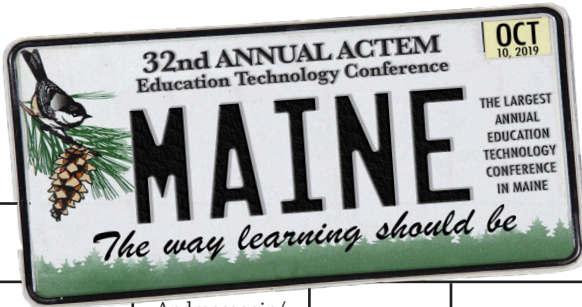
